Acceptable Identification List to Obtain Vital Records

ID must be current

Identification is required for all non-public Vital Records. Mailed requests must include an easily identifiable photocopy of the front and back of the identification from the list below or the application will be returned. One form of identification from the "Primary" list is required or two forms of identification from the "Secondary" list.

Secondary

(Need 2)

- Court order or court documents
- Jail/prison documents
- Probation documents
- Property tax receipt
- Selective Service card

- Professional license

<u>We cannot accept:</u> Novelty identification card or driving privilege card as prohibited by UCA 53-3-207(7)b)(ii).

If you cannot provide acceptable identification, you may have a spouse, parent, grandparent, sibling, or adult child who can provide appropriate identification request the certificate. Proof of relationship may be required.
