

# Notice of commencement of paternity proceedings

## General information

This form, along with a notice of commencement of paternity proceedings from the court, will be used to register a man in the Utah Putative Father Registry. The registry must be checked before a child can be adopted to be sure there is not a man who may be the child's father who would like the opportunity to raise the child. The registry does not establish paternity or add a father's name to the birth certificate. The timely filing of this form entitles you to notification of a proceeding for adoption of the child identified on the form.

Services are available through the DHHS Office of Vital Records and the Office of Recovery Services to help establish paternity of a child who is not placed for adoption. The information you give us will be used by DHHS to process your request to be added to the Utah Putative Father Registry. The information may also be shared with the Office of Recovery Services and used to establish paternity. If necessary, the data may be accessed by contractors who are a part of the DHHS technical team. You are advised to also file in other states if conception or birth of the child may have occurred there. If needed, we can provide you with contact information for other state vital records offices. Utah Judicial Code 78B-15-404. This data is part of the record series 28666. All fields are required. Failure to provide all required information may result in a delay in registration on the Utah Putative Father Registry.

A biological father must initiate proceedings with a district court in Utah to preserve any right to notice and consent in an adoption. The biological father must then file the "Notice of Commencement of Paternity Proceeding" form with the Utah Office of Vital Records. The biological father has the duty to protect his own rights and interests before the birth mother executes consent to adoption or relinquishes a child for adoption.

Utah Judicial Code 78B-15; 78B-6-Part 1 -125; and 78B-6-Part 1-122.

1. The Utah Office of Vital Records and Statistics requires the complete and accurate "Notice of Commencement of Paternity Proceeding" form along with a copy of the petition filed with a district court in Utah that contains the assigned case number. The Utah Office of Vital Records does not accept faxes or any other electronic communication.

2. The completed "Notice of Commencement of Paternity Proceeding" form and the copy of the court petition must be submitted to the Utah Office of Vital Records.

It is highly recommended that the request be hand delivered whenever possible. If mailed, it is recommended to send the request via certified mail or other traceable mail service.

3. Upon filing, the registrant will be given a photocopy of the registered "Notice of Commencement of Paternity Proceeding" form which will include the registration number, date, and time accepted and the stamp/signature of the state registrar. A receipt will also be issued indicating the date and time the form was accepted, the parties involved and will reflect the signature of the clerk who registered the form.

4. There is no fee to file this form. A certified copy of the filed "Notice of Commencement of Paternity Proceeding" is \$18.00 and requires you to submit form 304: Search for Notice of Commencement of Paternity Proceedings.
